

2009 Music Alumni Reunion at Texas State University October 30-31, 2009

Travel & Parking Information

1. Event Duration and Location

The event will start at 10:30am on Friday, October 30, and end in the evening on Saturday, October 31, 2009. The complete program can be accessed at <http://www.musicalumni.net>. Several of the events will be held in the Music Building at Texas State University.

2. Directions to the Music Building at Texas State University

Travel by Air: You may fly into Austin or San Antonio and rent a car.

Travel by Car: Take exit #206 from IH-35. Stay on the access road. If you are traveling from Austin / Dallas / Waco, you will merge RIGHT onto Aquarena Springs Drive / Loop 82. If you are traveling from San Antonio / Corpus Christi / Laredo and I-35 Corridor South, you will make a LEFT turn through the IH-35 underpass. While on Aquarena Springs Drive / Loop 82 you will pass two traffic lights and cross over a railroad track. Bobcat (football) Stadium will be on your left. You will pass another traffic light and then over the San Marcos River. At the next light turn RIGHT onto Sessom Drive. Driving on Sessom, turn LEFT onto North LBJ Drive. The Music Building is on the corner of Sessom and North LBJ.

3. Parking Information for Friday, October 30, 2009

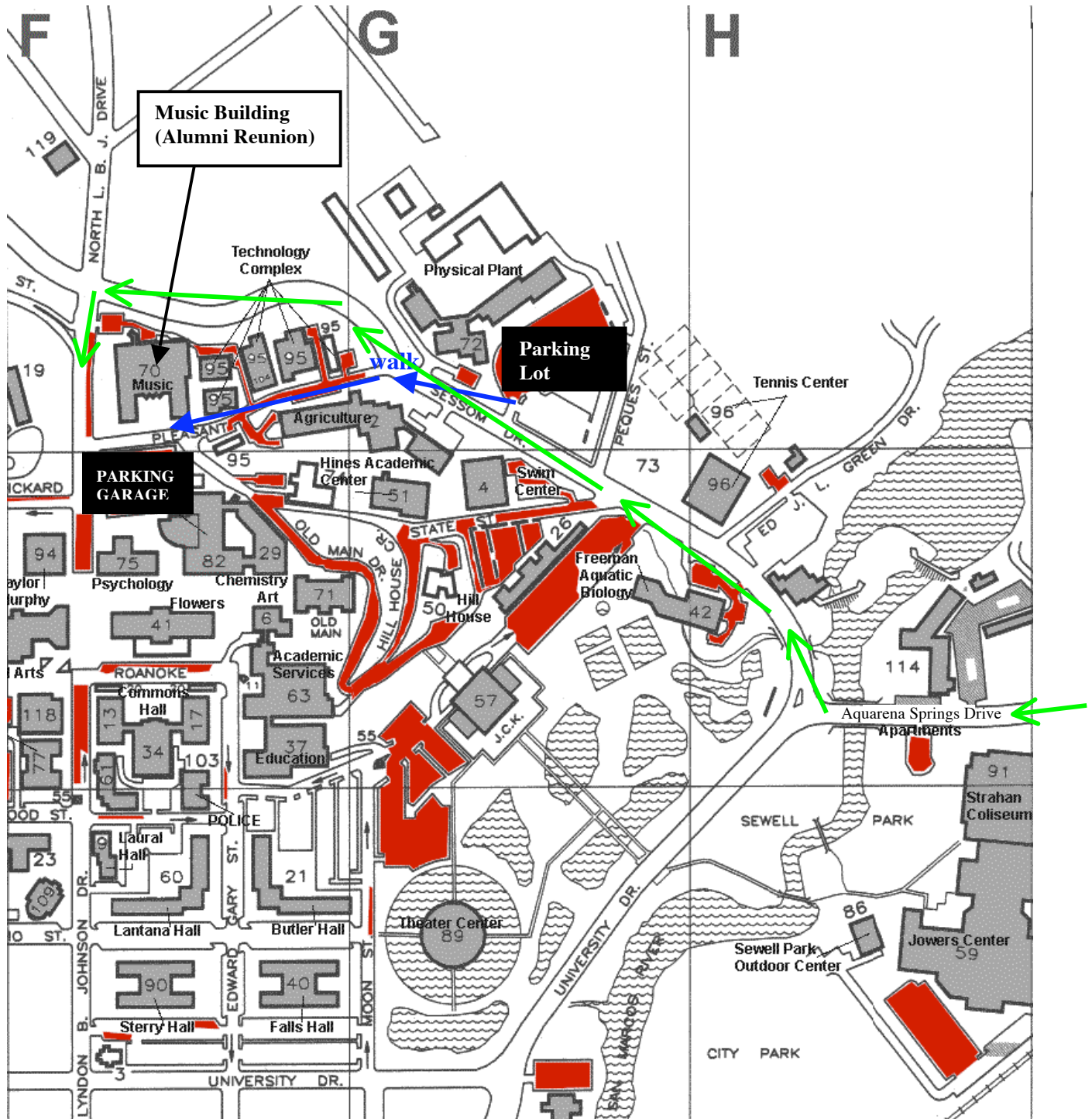
On Friday (October 30), you will need a guest parking permit to park on campus. Those guest permits will be available at the little house in the middle on the street – immediately when you turn from Sessom Drive LEFT onto North LBJ Drive. In that little house is a Parking Officer. Please mention “Music Alumni Reunion” and ask for a guest parking permit. You may park either in the Parking Garage next to the Music Building OR in the Parking Lot next to the Physical Plant – see the map further below: The green line highlights your driving path from Aquarena Springs Drive to Sessom Drive and to North LBJ. For those who park down the hill in the Parking Lot next to the Physical Plant: the blue line is the walking path to the Music Building. Reunion attendees may also park in the city and take a taxi to the Music Building. To call a taxi, call (512) 392-2222.

4. Parking Information for Saturday, October 31, 2009

On Saturday (October 31), Reunion attendees may park on campus without a parking permit. Those who attend the morning Breakfast in the LBJ Student Center --- you may park there. Shuttle buses will be available all day (since it’s also a University Open House as well as Homecoming), which could bring you to the Music Building (next to the main Bus Loop) and / or to the Football Stadium.

Those who attend the **Alumni Band Rehearsal at 9:30am**, please park in the STRAHAN Parking Lot (the Stadium Parking lot will not yet be open). The Strahan Parking Lot is WEST of the Football Stadium. Then walk over the railroad tracks and enter the Football Stadium through GATE 4, which is on the EAST side of the Stadium. (All other Gates will not be open that morning.)
