“Texas State’s School of Music is in the process of establishing a keyboard scholarship endowment. My husband and I are donating \$50 per month to this endowment. The scholarships will benefit pianists, including those who accompany other students. Thus, this scholarship fund will benefit the entire School of Music. Several faculty, among them Dr. Jason Kwak (Coordinator of the Piano Area), have pledged to match all alumni contributions 1:1.
